



THE 2019 LIONEL GELBER PRIZE

CALL *for* SUBMISSIONS

The Lionel Gelber Prize was founded in 1989 by Canadian diplomat Lionel Gelber. The prize is a literary award for the world's best non-fiction book in English on foreign affairs that seeks to deepen public debate on significant international issues. A prize of \$15,000 is awarded to the winner. The award is presented annually by The Lionel Gelber Foundation, in partnership with *Foreign Policy* magazine and the Munk School of Global Affairs and Public Policy at the University of Toronto.

To be eligible for the 2019 Lionel Gelber Prize, books must be published between 1 January 2018 and 31 December 2018. The deadline for submission is 31 October 2018. Manuscripts to be published between 31 October and 31 December 2018 may be submitted in galley form. A \$75 USD per entry handling fee is required. Please make all cheques payable to the University of Toronto.

This year's Lionel Gelber Prize winner is Anne Applebaum, for her book *Red Famine: Stalin's War on Ukraine* published by Signal/McClelland & Stewart/Penguin Random House.
